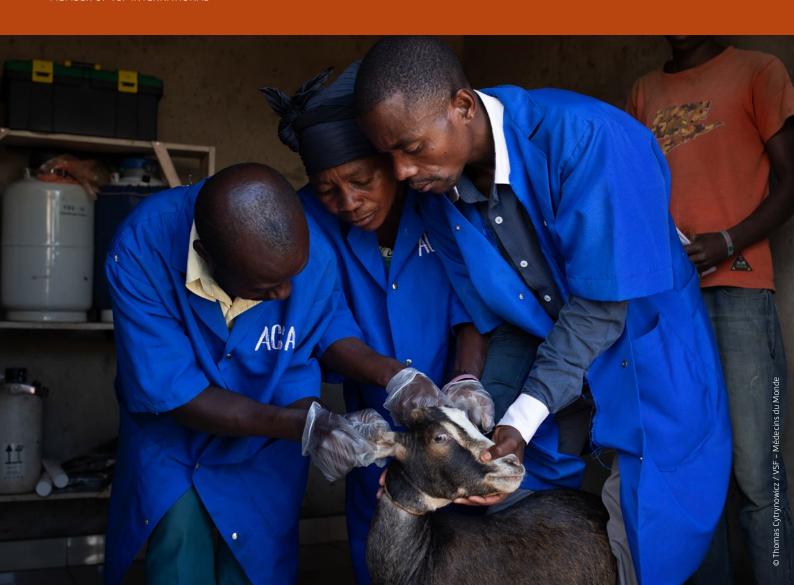

VÉTÉRINAIRES SANS FRONTIÈRES NETHERLANDS

MEMBER OF VSF INTERNATIONAL



This financial report concerns the consolidated annual accounts of Vétérinaires Sans Frontières-Netherlands for all activities between 1 January 2023 and 31 December 2023. The annual accounts were audited and approved by our auditing committee, consisting of Wilma Jongerman and Henk Arends.

Income and expenses 2023

For Vétérinaires Sans Frontières Netherlands (VSF-NL), donations are essential to achieve its goals. In 2023, we collected in total \in 96,572 in private donations, through the donation form on our website, bank transfers, the Give a Goat campaign, the Vaccinate For Africa campaign, Run 4 Rabies campaign, and fundraising with equity foundations. The Edgard & Cooper Foundation has supported us with a donation of \in 44,891, to implement our rabies projects in the 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} cycle. The 2nd cycle was fully completed in 2023, the 3^{rd} cycle has started and will continue in 2024.

The first four years after its foundation, Vétérinaires Sans Frontières Belgium (VSF-Belgium) supported Vétérinaires Sans Frontières-Netherlands technically and financially. In 2023 VSF-Belgium contributed € 7,500 to cover the expected budget deficit. 2023 is the last year that VSF-NL has received a financial contribution from VSF-Belgium. From 2024 onwards we only expect technical support.

In 2023, VSF-NL cooperated with VSF-Belgium in for the project Operationalization of the One Health approach in South Kivu Democratic Republic of Congo (DR Congo) through local veterinary services, VSF-NL has applied for funds within the Netherlands. The project is carried out by VSF-Belgium and its local partners. The Willem Meindert de Hoop foundation has made a contribution of € 15,000, which directly benefited the project activities in DR Congo. The total budget of this project is € 67,904.

Last year we rewrote our project proposal 'Enhancing Livestock Farmers' Access To Markets', aimed at livestock farming in Malawi. A commitment had already been made by Wilde Ganzen to support this project, and a gift of € 3,000 has also been made by a family fund. Due to changes in the local chain of animal production in northern Malawi, the previously proposed activities no longer all appeared to be relevant. Some of the activities have remained the same and have been included in the new 'Strengthening Capacity in Animal Production and Health for Enhanced Livelihoods (SCAPH4EL)' proposal, the total budget has remained the same at € 56,904. We will continue fundraising for that project proposal in early 2024 so that the project can hopefully be implemented from the second half of 2024.

The remaining expenses consist of education, communication, fundraising, activities organized by Vétérinaires Sans Frontières Student (VSF-Student), management and administration, such as salary for the coordinator, travel costs, and remuneration for the interns. In 2020 we adopted a new corporate identity. Based on this, new communication materials were also developed in 2023.

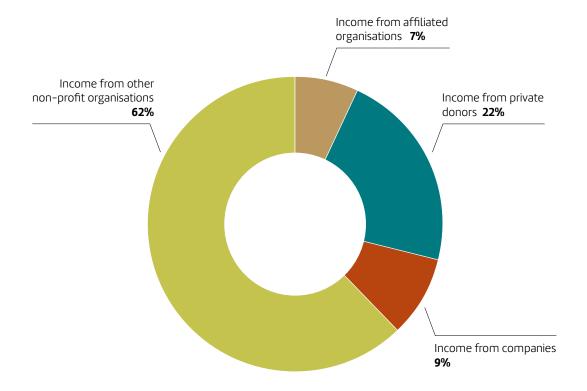
From 2020 to 2023 we cooperated with the Toegift.nl campaign, an initiative for cooperating charities, that raises awareness amongst people of the possibilities of leaving part of their will to charities. The expenses are now \in 2,500 per year. Due to the anticipated budget deficit, we have decided to stop participation in Toegift (at least temporarily) in 2023. In 2023, we further expanded our legacy strategy and placed an advertisement in a newspaper for the first time.

The members of the board do not receive any remuneration for their activities.

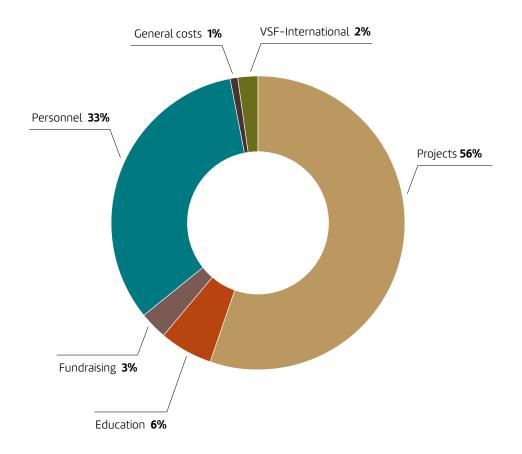
VSF-Student is part of VSF-NL. In 2023, VSF-Student had an income of € 3,236.93. Of this amount, € 1,000 was contributed by VSF-NL for carrying out activities. The total expenses were € 3,236.99, which means that VSF-Student 2023 ended with a small negative result of € 0.06. VSF-Student makes an important contribution to the annual income of VSF-NL by organizing campaigns such as Vaccinate for Africa (€ 4,053), Run4Rabies (€ 802), and Give a goat (€ 3,051). In addition, many students have become donors to VSF-NL through VSF-Student for € 7.50 per year and the activities of VSF-Student contribute to the awareness of VSF-NL, resulting in more people becoming donors.

For VSF-NL, 2023 ended with a negative result of € 9,279.70. € 6,905 was deducted from the earmarked fund for the projects in Malawi. The earmarked fund now contains € 3,000 for the SCAPH4EL project in Malawi. € 2,374.70 was deducted from the continuity reserve.
